


ORIENTATION WORKSHOP ON WOMEN LEADERS NETWORK

Strategic Management of Social Enterprise

The 16th HELP Training on Strategic Management of Social Enterprise (SMSE) was held on April 24-26, 2013. The fundamental objective of the programme was to provide participants with a deeper understanding of the strategic management challenges faced by social enterprises and approaches used by other social enterprises in overcoming these challenges.

17 participants, who are serving as founders, senior managers and board members in social sector, attended the training programme. Ehsan UI Haque was the Programme Director for the training programme. LUMS faculty members Ehsan UI Haque, Mohsin Bashir and guest speaker Zafar Iqbal Qureshi facilitated the training programme. Majority of the participants came from the organisations Marie Stopes Society, Shaukat Khanum and Strengthening Participatory Organisation.

Qualitative Research for Social Sector Initiatives



The 17th HELP Training on Qualitative Research for Social Sector Initiatives (QRSSI) was held on May 22-24, 2013. The fundamental objective of the programme was to equip participants with the most rigorous and recent qualitative research frameworks and analytical tools and techniques. 23 participants attended the training programme. Syed Mubashir Ali was the Programme Director for the training programme. LUMS faculty members Syed Mubashir Ali, Anjum Fayyaz, Mohsin Bashir and Naiman Jalil facilitated the training

Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning Systems

The 18th HELP Training on Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning Systems (MEALS) was held on June 26-28, 2013. The fundamental objective of the programme was to provide participants understanding of how to implement M&E within their organisational context utilising the fundamental functions of evaluation, performance improvement and accountability.

NLRHD PROJECT REVIEW MEETING

The David & Lucile Packard Foundation team organised a Project Review Meeting with SEDC team on April 9, 2013 at LUMS. The objective of the meeting was to review the work plan for the third year of the National Leadership for Reproductive Health & Development (NLRHD) project, to understand the budget implications in view of new agreement signed in January 2013 and to ensure the compliance policy.

The action items that were highlighted in the meeting included: finalising the pool of Women Leaders for Women Leaders Network, finalising strategy papers after receiving them from the Strategy Paper Working Groups, conducting a five-day training programme for Women Leaders, conducting a National Conference as an advocacy seminar for SEDC fellows and conducting Combined Working Group (CWG) meetings with LEAD Pakistan.

3rd COMBINED WORKING GROUP (CWG) MEETING

The David & Lucile Packard Foundation team organised the third Combined Working Group (CWG) Meeting with LEAD Pakistan and SEDC-LUMS on June 17, 2013.

The agenda of the meeting was to take project updates from both LEAD and LUMS, to review the progress of both organisations against MLE framework and to encourage both organisations to actively participate in each other Women Leaders meetings. As next steps, both LEAD and LUMS agreed to meet periodically and to share the outcomes of their respective project goals with each other.
